RESOLUTION SUBJECT: REVISION OF SNOHOMISH HEALTH DISTRICT SANITARY CODE
CHAPTER 8.1: ADOPTING WAC 246-272A, RULES AND
REGULATIONS GOVERNING ONSITE SEWAGE SYSTEMS

WHEREAS the State Board of Health has adopted revisions to WAC 246-272, Rules and Regulations governing Onsite Sewage Systems, now referred to as WAC 246-272A, effective July 1, 2007, and


WHEREAS WAC 246-272A-0005 requires that the local Health Officer and the Washington State Department of Health administer and enforce such regulations, and

WHEREAS WAC 246-272A-0015(9) requires that local rules and regulations governing onsite sewage systems be consistent with, and at least as stringent as, WAC 246-272A,

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Health of Snohomish Health District hereby takes the following actions:


- (1) Rescinds the current version of WAC 246-272, Chapter 8.1 of the Snohomish Health District Sanitary Code, Rules and Regulations Governing Onsite Sewage Disposal, adopted January 1, 1995;
- (2) Adopts WAC 246-272A, Rules and Regulations of the State Board of Health Governing Onsite Sewage Systems, adopted September 15, 2005 by the Washington State Board of Health, as Chapter 8.1 of the Snohomish Health District Sanitary Code, to be administered and enforced by the Snohomish Health District;
- (3) Amends Chapter 8 of the Snohomish Health District Sanitary Code consistent with WAC 246-272A;
- (4) Authorizes the Health Officer to maintain administrative procedures and practices of the Onsite Sewage Disposal Program currently in effect, which are not in conflict with WAC 246-272A;
- (5) Authorizes the Health Officer to adopt future revisions to WAC 246-272A, Rules and Regulations of the State Board of Health Governing Onsite Sewage Systems as Chapter 8.1 of the Snohomish Health District Sanitary Code within sixty days after the adoption date of the revision as established by the Washington State Board of Health.
