RESOLUTION SUBJECT: REVISION OF SNOHOMISH HEALTH DISTRICT SANITARY CODE  
CHAPTER 1.4: APPLICABILITY AND DEFINITIONS: PERMITS

WHEREAS in order to preserve, promote and improve the public health, and as set forth in chapter 70.05.060 RCW, the Snohomish Health District Board of Health has adopted rules known as the SANITARY CODE of the Snohomish Health District Board of Health, and

WHEREAS the duties and functions derived from the Sanitary Code of the Snohomish Health District Board of Health includes issuance of permits or written approvals, and


WHEREAS issuance of permits or written approvals may include payment of fees, and

WHEREAS applicants for permits or written approvals may be delinquent in payment of prior fees,


NOW THEREFORE the Board of Health of Snohomish Health District hereby amends Chapter 1.4 of the Snohomish Health District Sanitary Code to include the following:

The Snohomish Health District may deny an application for permit, permit renewal or written approval if the applicant has outstanding monies owed to the Snohomish Health District for permit fees, reinspection fees, late fees, checks returned by the bank, civil penalties, or other miscellaneous fees.

# SNOHOMISH HEALTH DISTRICT SANITARY CODE

## Chapter 1.4

### Permits

- A. All applications for permits or written approval herein required shall be made upon forms prescribed and furnished by the Health District, and shall be signed by the applicant or authorized agent of the person responsible for compliance with the conditions of the permit. Such application shall contain such data and information and be accompanied by such plans as may be required.
- B. A permit issued to a particular person or for a designated place, purpose or vehicle shall not be valid for use by any other person or for any other place, purpose or vehicle than that designated therein. Such permits or written approvals may contain general and specific conditions and every person who shall have obtained a permit or written approval as herein required shall conform to the conditions prescribed in said permit or written approval and to the provisions of the Sanitary Code. Every such permit shall expire as stated on the permit and may be renewed by the Health Officer, suspended for cause by the Health Officer, or revoked by the Health officer after due notice and process.
- C. The Snohomish Health District may deny an application for permit, permit renewal or written approval if the applicant has outstanding monies owed to the Snohomish Health District for permit fees, reinspection fees, late fees, checks returned by the bank, civil penalties, or other miscellaneous fees.

## Chapter 1.5

### Fee Schedules

Fees for permits and other services provided for through the enactment of the provisions of this Sanitary Code shall be as set forth by the Board of Health in the Fee Schedule. Such fees shall be set initially by the Board, and shall be subject to revision commensurate with the cost of delivering the service, and the changing nature and complexity of the subject regulation. All fees collected under the provisions of this Sanitary Code shall be payable to the Snohomish Health District.

## Chapter 1.6

### Serving of Notices

Any notice required to be served on a person, owner, agent or occupant of a premise, shall be deemed to have been served under any of the following conditions:
