## RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION OF THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE Snohomish Health District

Resolution No. SR16-005

WHEREAS, all of Snohomish County is exposed to natural hazards that present risks to life, property, the environment, and the economy; and

WHEREAS, proactive mitigation can reduce or eliminate these risks; and

WHEREAS, The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) established new requirements for pre- and post-disaster hazard mitigation programs; and

WHEREAS, a coalition of Snohomish County, Cities, Tribes and Special Purpose Districts with like planning objectives has been formed to pool resources and create consistent mitigation strategies within the county; and

WHEREAS, the 2010 edition of the Snohomish County Hazard Mitigation Plan has been updated, the coalition has completed a planning process that engages the public, assesses the risk and vulnerability to the impacts of natural hazards, develops a mitigation strategy consistent with a set of uniform goals and objectives, and creates a plan for implementing, evaluating, and revising this strategy; and

WHEREAS, the coalition has completed a planning process that reviewed and/or revised the risk assessment, goals and objectives, action plan, and reengaged the public; and

WHEREAS, FEMA has completed pre-adoption review of the revised Snohomish County Hazard Mitigation Plan pursuant to 44 CFR Part 201, and Board adoption must occur for the Snohomish Health District to have a FEMA approved Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Snohomish Health District:

- 1. Adopts Volume 1 in its entirety and adopts the following portions of Volume 2: Part 1; Snohomish Health District annex in Part 8; and all Volume 2 appendices of the Snohomish County Hazard Mitigation Plan (SC HMP). A copy of said documents shall be available for review and inspection at the Snohomish Health District Administration office.
- 2. Will utilize the adopted portions of the 2015 Snohomish County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update to guide pre- and post-disaster mitigation of the Snohomish Health District's identified hazards.
- 3. Will coordinate the strategies identified in the 2015 Snohomish County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update with other planning efforts under its jurisdictional authority.
