RESOLUTION NUMBER: 19-21

RESOLUTION SUBJECT: ADOPTING THE ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, the Board of Health is authorized pursuant to RCW 70.50.060 to establish fees for services;
and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health recognizes individuals should pay for services through fees and these fees
should be based on the reasonable cost of providing the service; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health has determined that the existing fee structure requires amendments to
recover the reasonable cost of providing a wide array of local environmental health services as well as
providing responsible cost recovery for staff and consultant time required to provide certain services and
functions; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health wishes to make adjustments to fees to more closely reflect actual cost of
services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF HEALTH AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The schedule of fees and charges attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as Exhibit
1 is hereby adopted effective November 1, 2019.

Section 2. The Board of Health hereby finds that the fees and charges set forth in Exhibit 1 reflect the
reasonable costs of providing the services set forth therein.

Section 3. This Resolution and the attached Exhibit 1 shall replace any previous fee schedule related to
Environmental Health Services.
