WHEREAS, the administration of Snohomish Health District has prepared Supplemental Budget No. 2 to provide for the needed capital outlay items and for 50% of the operating expenses of the clinic with the additional revenue to be derived from the TB Control Budget,

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Health of Snohomish Health District does hereby adopt the attached Supplemental Budget No. 2 increasing the 1972 agency Budget from \$863,030 to \$891,356.00 and the Tuberculosis Control Budget from \$107,523 to \$135,849.00
