NOW THEREFORE, the BOARD OF HEALTH of Snohomish Health District does adopt the attached Supplemental Budget Number Two increasing the Agency Budget for 1973 from $\$ 1,084,569$ to $\$ 1,122,369$ (an increase of $\$ 37,800$ ).
