RESOLUTION SUBJECT: CLAIM FOR DAMAGES REJECTED


ON MOTION, the CLAIM FOR DAMAGES served upon the Health Officer of Snohomish Health District February 26, 1975 by Lucille Hansen of 2110 Everett Avenue, Everett, Washington 98201, for an amount of not less than \$50,000.00 for medical expenses, lost wages and/or profits from the operation of claimant's business and other general damages resulting from the alleged negligence of agents of the Snohomish County Health District is hereby REJECTED.

C L A I M



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TO: DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH
OF THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY HEALTH DISTRICT

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that in accordance with Chapter 4.96 of the Revised Code of Washington, I LUCILLE HANSEN, hereby present you with my claim for damages against the Snohomish County Health District, Snohomish County, State of Washington, with the information required to be given by RCW 4.96.020 as follows:

1. That the name and actual residence of the Claimant at the time of presenting and filing this claim is as follows:

That the claimant has resided at the same address as above described for a period of six months immediately prior to the time the claim herein described arose.

2. That on or about November 1, 1974 the claimant contracted Toxic Hepatitis as a proximate result of the side effects of certain medication prescribed to the claimant by employees and agents of the Department of Health of the Snohomish County Health District, Snohomish County, State of Washington, which medication was administered and prescribed for the prevention and spread of infectious tuberculosis. That said medication was prescribed on or about August, 1974 by persons whose names are unknown to claimant. That claimant was still taking said medication at the time she contracted the Toxic Hepatitis. That as a proximate result of the side effects of the medication

1 prescribed (which medication is believed to be Osoniazid) and
2 as a proximate result of the failure of the agents and repre-
3 sentatives of the Snohomish County Health District to adequately
4 warn or safeguard the claimant against the possible side effects
5 of the medication, the claimant contracted Toxic Hepatitis and
6 did suffer damages in the form of pain and suffering, humiliation,
7 medical expenses, lost wages and/or profits from the operation
8 of claimant's business, etc., all in an amount of not less than
9 \$50,000.00.
