RESOLUTION SUBJECT:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE  
WITHDRAWAL OF SNOHOMISH HEALTH  
DISTRICT FROM THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT  
MERIT PROGRAM

WHEREAS Snohomish Health District was informed by the State Department of Health in 1969 that it would be necessary to become a member of a federally approved merit system in order to receive federal 314 (d) and federal MCH monies, and

WHEREAS after investigation the Board of Health found the only merit system available to the District to be the Local Government Merit System operated by the State Department of Personnel, and

WHEREAS as authorized by Resolution 6 - 71 dated June 15, 1971 the District did sign a contract with the State Department of Personnel and the State Department of Social and Health Services to join the Local Government Merit System, and


WHEREAS the District has now learned that it is no longer a federal requirement to belong to a merit system in order to receive 314 (d) monies, and

WHEREAS the District has been dissatisfied with the service provided by the Local Government Merit System and found such system to significantly interfere with the internal operations of the District, and


WHEREAS the District has communicated its concerns to the Department of Personnel and has been unable to resolve the existing problems,

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Health does authorize the Health Officer to formally terminate the contract with the State Department of Personnel and the State Department of Social and Health Services effective October 31, 1977.
