**RESOLUTION SUBJECT:** 

ADOPTION OF "INTERIM GUIDELINES FOR DETERMINING WATER AVAILABILITY FOR NEW BUILDINGS" AND FEES FOR REVIEW

AND INSPECTION OF INDIVIDUAL WATER SUPPLIES

WHEREAS the Growth Management Act of 1990 (ch. 17, Laws of 1990. 1st Ex. Sess.) requires proof of the availability of potable water as a part of the approval process for subdivisions and building permits; and

WHEREAS the Snohomish County Division of Community Development has required applicants for a building permit to provide a certificate of water availability; and

WHEREAS the Snohomish County Division of Community Planning requires evidence of potable water as part of the subdivision approval process; and

WHEREAS Snohomish Health District has the expertise in its Environmental Health Division to inspect small water supplies, and

WHEREAS the County has determined that review and recommendation by Snohomish Health District is sufficient to meet the requirements of ch. 17, Laws of 1990, 1st Ex. Sess., and

WHEREAS the Board of Health of Snohomish Health District is empowered pursuant to RCW 70.05.060 to enact such local rules and regulations as are necessary in order to preserve, promote, and improve the public health, and to establish fee schedules for such services as are authorized by law, provided that such fees shall not exceed the cost of providing any such services,

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Health of Snohomish Health District adopts the attached document entitled: "Interim Guidelines for Determining Water Availability for New Buildings", issued July 6, 1990, from the Washington State Department of Ecology, or the latest revision thereof, and subsequent State regulations adopted pursuant to such guidelines; and establishes the following fees:

- (1) <u>Application for Individual Water Supply Review</u> \$130.00, or \$70.00 if application is submitted concurrently with an Application for Onsite Sewage Disposal Permit,
- (2) Individual Water Supply Clearance for Building Permit \$20.00.
