**RESOLUTION SUBJECT: REVISING FOOD PROGRAM ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES**

WHEREAS the "Enforcement Procedures of the Food Program" were initially adopted pursuant to WAC 246-215-229 (formerly WAC 248-84-110) by Snohomish Health District Board of Health Resolution 85 - 43, and


WHEREAS the Enforcement Procedures provide for the frequency of inspections at food establishments in compliance with WAC 246-215-179, and

WHEREAS both the current knowledge concerning safe food sanitation practices, as well as the District's recent history of food establishment inspections have indicated there is an increasing need for more frequent inspection in food establishments with complex methods of preparation of potentially hazardous foods, and a corresponding reduced need for inspection in low risk limited service food establishments, and


WHEREAS the modification of inspection frequency according to identified food establishment performance characteristics and associated public health risk factors will allow the Snohomish Health District to utilize its inspection staff efforts in a more effective manner,

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Health does adopt the modifications to the inspection frequency, section I. A. of the "Enforcement Procedures of the Food Program", as outlined on the attached revision 4 of that document.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES OF THE FOOD PROGRAM/REV.4**

I. Inspection Frequency/Inspection Form.

- A. Inspection Frequency: Food establishments will be generally ~~inspected every six months. Establishments not open 12 months per year may be inspected less often;~~ **inspected as often as required according to frequencies set by the Health Officer.** Establishments with identified problems and establishments about which complaints are received will be subject to a more frequent inspection schedule.
