RESOLUTION NUMBER: 93-32

RESOLUTION SUBJECT: REVISING THE SANITARY CODE OF SNOHOMISH HEALTH DISTRICT

WHEREAS under the provisions of RCW 70.05.060, the Snohomish Health District Board of Health is empowered to have supervision over all matters pertaining to the preservation of the life and health of the people within its jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of Snohomish Health District shall enforce through the Health Officer the public health statutes of the State and rules promulgated by the State Board of Health and the Secretary of Health, and

WHEREAS the Board of Health of the Snohomish Health District shall supervise the maintenance of all health and sanitary measures for the protection of the public health within its jurisdiction, and provide for the control and prevention of any dangerous, contagious or infectious disease within its jurisdiction, and provide for the prevention, control and abatement of nuisances detrimental to the public health, and

WHEREAS the Board of Health of Snohomish Health District adopted such local rules and regulations necessary in order to preserve, promote and improve the public health and provide for the enforcement thereof in a document titled Sanitary Code of Snohomish County, State of Washington, dated 1957 and amended in 1962, and

WHEREAS the Board of Health of Snohomish Health District has also responded to changing conditions within the community and to the growing numbers and increasing complexity of the matters of public health under its supervision, and has adopted numerous additional rules, regulations and policies over the following years, and

WHEREAS the cumulative effect of these new regulations and the changes that have occurred within other State statutes has been to supersede most of the language and earlier requirements of the existing Sanitary Code of Snohomish County dated 1957,

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Health of Snohomish Health District does adopt the compiled volume of current regulations, procedures and requirements into the Sanitary Code of Snohomish Health District, and furthermore does rescind all of the previous regulations, requirements and amendments to the Sanitary Code of Snohomish County dated 1957.
