Chairman McCollum appointed Messrs. Gebert and Wyatt as the Auditing Committee.


Doctor Knipe reported that an agreement had been made County with the County Commissioners for a service charge of Garage \$1.00 for lubrication, \$1.00 for oil changes (not to include cost of oil and filters) and a charge of \$2.50 per hour for other labor (all parts to be supplied by the Health District). It was moved by Doctor Stocker and seconded by Mr. Gebert that, in that insofar as these charges represented county cost, that they be approved and that this be entered in the minutes. Carried.

Doctor Knipe reported that the meeting which had been arranged in March with the State Senators and Representatives had not taken place due to their previous committments. It was agreed that a meeting later in the year would be preferable, after elections. Representatives

Mr. C. Stretch, owner of the Startup Cafe in Startup, Washington had again requested an appearance before the Board of Health. He did not, however, appear at this meeting. (Please see minutes of March 8th meeting).

Mr. Stockton reported that his division has had numerous calls from the city asking for enforcement of the City of Everett Trailer Ordinance. Usually, these have been on alleged parking violations. It was the consensus of the members that parking was not a public health problem and that the matter should be discussed with the City Attorney by Mr. Stockton to work out a satisfactory agreement as to the enforcing of this ordinance, public health-wise and other.

Salary Change The Health Officer requested authority to change Miss Forsgren's salary as a clerk-typist from the present of \$248.00 to \$270.00 per month effective 4/1/60. This

ReportDoctor Phillip Millard gave a brief resume of his work
in the Department in meat and butcher shop licenses and
inspections, county and city, and some of the animal
diseases transmissible to man. After discussion, it was
agreed that the matter of conflict between the City Ordi-
nances and the County Sanitary Code should be looked into
with the thought that perhaps later the District Board
of Health might wish to include all ordinances, rules,
regulations and codes under one measure.
