MINUTES SNOHOMISH DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH Meeting of December 13, 1960 2 p.m.

Present

Members, Mrs. Simpson, Messrs. McCollum, Johnson, Kraetz, Wyatt and Doctor Stocker. Also, Doctor Knipe, Mrs. Chambers, Mrs. Rands, Miss Findlay, Mr. Stockton and Mr. Weller.

Member absent: Mr. Gebert.

Minutes

Moved by Mr. Kraetz, seconded by Mr. Wyatt and carried that minutes of last meeting, as previously circulated to members, be approved.

Auditing Committee

Chairman McCollum appointed Messrs. Kraetz and Johnson as the Auditing Committee.

Vital Statistics

The matter of the Health Officer's recommendation in transferring recording of vital statistics from the City Hall to the Health District office was again discussed. Health Officer had written to the City recommending such a change as a result of the Board's request at the last meeting.

The original agreement (in creation of the Health District) between the City and County was reviewed. At that time it had been agreed that the City would continue to register, and collect fees for, vital statistics for Registrars' Districts M-1 and D-5 (City and Rural Everett). It was pointed out by Mr. Johnson that the City had budgeted approximately \$1700 income in the 1961 budget. It was agreed that if this recommendation were acted upon, then the Health District could either transfer to the City any fees collected on its' behalf, or deduct a corresponding amount from the City's annual share of the Health District budget. It was felt that this latter method would be preferable.

It was thereupon moved by Mrs. Simpson, seconded by Mr. Kraetz, and carried, that the matter of registration of vital statistics for the City of Everett and Rural Everett be referred to the attorneys of the City and the Board of Health immediately after consideration by the City Council, for revision of that portion of the Agreement dated January 1, 1959 between the City and the County, dealing with the collection of vital statistics by the City of Everett; such revision to be mutually satisfactory to all parties; and further, that the Chairman of the Snohomish District Board of Health be empowered to sign on its' behalf.

During the discussion of the Agreement, the matter of janitor and telephone service and the general inadequacy of the Laboratory quarters in the City Hall was discussed. It was generally agreed that this was a bad situation, but should be considered only in the light of the overall inadequacies of space and housing of the Health Department as a whole. Mr. Johnson stated if the arrangement whereby the Health District office would register vital statistics at the central office be carried through, then the City would have no further need for the Health Department listing (AL 2-1770) in the City Hall.

Air Pollution

Mr. Stockton outlined the new air pollution monitor which had been set up on the roof of the Agriculture Building next to the Health Department. This is part of a nationwide monitoring grid for dust and other particulate matter.

Staff Changes

The resignation of Mrs. Katharine Hall Chambers, Public Health Social Worker, effective December 31, 1960 was accepted with regret.

Doctor Knipe, in introducing Mr. Bruce Weller to the Board, requested approval of his appointment as Public Health Social Worker effective January 1, 1961, at \$492 monthly. This appointment was approved on motion by Doctor Stocker, seconded by Mr. Johnson, and carried.

Payroll Deductions

Health Officer requested the Board's further consideration of authorizing staff payroll deductions for medical insurance, U.G.N., etc. Several members expressed themselves as being in favor of this. The matter was again left with Mr. McCollum, the Chairman, to work out a satisfactory arrangement with the County Auditor and Treasurer.

Notice of Annual Meeting

Health Officer stated that, according to the Charter of the Board of Health, the next meeting (January 10, 1961) would be the Annual Meeting when election of officers should be held.

Reports

Public Health Social Worker: As appended. Appreciation to Mrs. Chambers for her work during the past two and a half years with the Department was evidenced by the members.

Financial: As appended.

Health Officer presented a proposed 1961 Budget, as appended, in the total amount of \$281,124, as follows:
