MINUTES SNOHOMISH DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH February 13, 1962

Present:

Members, Mrs. Simpson, and Messrs. McCollum, Johnson, Kraetz, Wyatt, and Doctor Stocker. Also, Doctor Beare, Mr. Bell, Mrs. Supper and Mr. Stockton.

Minutes

Moved by Mr. Kraetz, seconded by Mr. Johnson, and carried that the minutes of the January meeting and as previously circulated to members, be approved.

Auditing Committee Chairman McCollum appointed Mrs. Simpson and Mr. Kraetz as the Auditing Committee.

Auto Accident Dr. Beare reported that William Franklin, Sanitarian, was involved in an automobile accident on January 22, 1962, at the intersection of 208th S.W. and Highway 99. As the negligence was on the part of Mr. Franklin, the Health District obtained estimates for repairs and had the automobile repaired for \$127.50. Damage to the other two cars involved was negligible.

Acting Health Officer Mr. McCollum read the resignation of Dr. K. H. Kinard, effective February 15. Dr. Beare stated that he had discussed this matter with Dr. Wallace Lane, Chief of the Division of Local Health Services of the Washington State Department of Health, and a letter from Dr. Lane was read concerning the possible temporary appointment of a Seattle-King County physician as Acting Health Officer. Discussion followed. Mr. Johnson suggested that Dr. J. W. Ebert, Jr. might be interested, and Dr. Stocker suggested that Dr. J. Walton Darrough had expressed interest. Motion made by Mrs. Simpson, seconded by Dr. Stocker, and carried, that Dr. Darrough be contacted and asked if he would consider the position of temporary Acting Health Officer. Mr. Johnson added that the motion should include the addition that, in the event Dr. Darrough did not accept, Dr. Ebert be contacted. This was accepted by the Board. After further discussion, Mrs. Simpson made the motion, seconded by Mr. Wyatt, and carried, that Dr. Stocker, Mr. McCollum, and Dr. Beare be named as a committee to approach Dr. Darrough.

Reports

Dr. Beare reported that the Health District was continuing the program set up by Dr. Knipe with no letdown, and that the morale of the employees very good.

Sanitation Activity: Reports for January, as appended. Mr. Stockton said that the problem of controlling rodents at the city dump had not yet been solved. His department had made two trips to the dump in January for that reason. He reported that the State of Washington had passed regulations for temporary camping vehicles which would be of great benefit during Century 21. He also brought up the question of enforcing

regulations for septic tanks, etc. in the newly annexed areas to Everett. Mr. Johnson concurred that they should be enforced under City Ordinance No. 10.56.090, and that the City Plumbing Inspector should send the notices for correction.

Vital Statistics: For December, as appended.

Financial: Dr. Beare stated, as a point of information, that the fleet of automobiles was requiring more repairs, and he anticipated the Auto Maintenance budget being depleted before the end of the year.
