Minutes

Moved by Mrs. Simpson, seconded by Mr. Wyatt, and carried that the minutes of the March meeting and as previously circulated to members, be approved.

Auditing Committee Chairman McCollum appointed Mrs. Simpson and Mr. Kraetz as the Auditing Committee.

Staff Appointment Moved by Mrs. Simpson, seconded by Mr. Kraetz, and carried that Acting Health Officer's appointment of James Smith as General Sanitarian, effective April 9, 1962, at a monthly salary of \$414, be approved.

Tolerance Board Mr. Johnson requested that Mr. Stockton attend meetings of the City of Everett Tolerance Board, which has been established to hear complaints concerning the illegal parking of trailers within the city limits during Century 21.

Budgetary Transfer Moved by Mr. Kraetz, seconded by Mrs. Simpson, and carried, that the attached resolution providing for transfer of monies from the "SALARIES" portion of the 1962 budget to "MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION - FEES" to pay for fees for services presented by Dr. Darrough and Firland Sanatorium, be approved.

Reports:

Dr. Darrough made a short report on sanitation activity in the south end of the County.

Mr. Johnson reported that the City of Everett is hoping to establish a uniform garbage collection ordinance in the near future. Such action would help to solve the existing rodent problem in the city. Mr. Johnson was assured Health District backing to see such a measure established.

Mr. Stockton discussed the necessity and advantages for establishing in Snohomish County a raw milk ordinance in compliance with the uniform standards of the U.S. Public Health Department. The City of Everett presently has such an ordinance; therefore to create equalization of standards within all of Snohomish County, all new regulations would be the responsibility of the Snohomish County Commissioners.

Sanitation Report: For March, as appended.

<u>Vital Statistics:</u> For February, as appended. Dr. Beare spoke of a new Health District procedure for keeping statistics of accidental deaths. This procedure will greatly facilitate the accumulation of data when requests for this information are received from other agencies.
