MINUTES SNOHOMISH DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH May 8, 1962

<u>Present</u> Members, Mrs. Simpson, Messrs. McCollum, Stocker, Johnson, Kraetz, Wyatt, Gebert, Also, Miss Findlay, Dr. Darrough, Dr. Beare, Dr. Millard, Mr. Ingram, Mr. Stockton, and Mrs. Supper.

<u>Minutes</u> Moved by Mrs. Simpson, seconded by Mr. Kraetz, and carried that the minutes of the April meeting and as previously circulated to members, be approved.

AuditingChairman McCollum appointed Mr. Gebert and Mr. Wyatt as theCommitteeAuditing Committee.

Automobile <u>Accident</u> <u>Accid</u>

Budgetary <u>Transfer</u> Moved by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mrs. Simpson, and carried that the attached resolution providing for transfer of monies from the "SALARIES" portion of the 1962 budget to "MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION-FEES" to pay for fees for services presented by Dr. Darrough and Firland Sanatorium, be adopted.

Local Health Officers Council Dr. Beare presented a plan for a Local Health Officer's Council to be composed of Health Officers from each city and town in Snohomish County. This council would meet periodically to review the Health District program, discuss problem areas within the County, and act in an advisory capacity to the Health Officer. The plan was discussed by the members, and Dr. Beare was advised to get the reaction of the Local Health Officers to the plan. The discussion will be continued at the next meeting of the Board.

<u>Reports:</u> Dr. Darrough reported that several septic tank drainage problems in the south end of the County were being solved satisfactorily to both the builders and the Health District. He also stated that the Health District had not approved Lake Stevens as a site for the Red Cross swimming classes next summer.

> Dr. Beare reported a marked increase in the number of cases of measles and whooping cough in the State and County during April, with appreciable increases also seen in cases of streptococcal disease.

Sanitation Report: For April, as appended.

Mr. Stockton called attention to a City of Everett ordinance concerning trailer parks which sets a fee of \$1 per lot with a minimum charge of \$50 per park, and asked permission for the Health District to collect this fee on all trailer parks which are now in the City of Everett and those added due to annexations of county land. He also pointed out that the Plumbing Code recently adopted by the County of Snohomish set a fee of \$10 for septic tank inspections, whereas the Health District at present charges \$5. Reports cont'd He pointed out that the extra revenue is needed by the Health District as the cost of the inspections is not covered by the present fees. The City Commissioners and the County Commissioners agreed to consider these inquiries, but did not take definite action. Mr. Ingram pointed out the need of resolving the differences in fees and penalties between the Sanitary Code, the Plumbing Code, and the City Ordinances, so that the Health Officer may carry out his legal duties more comprehensively. The members agreed and also pointed out the need to bring the ordinances of other cities and towns in Snohomish County under the same uniformity.

Dr. Millard spoke briefly on the proposed new City of Everett meat ordinance, and also pointed out that inspections of food establishments located in distant rural areas were far more costly than those situated in the metropolis area.
