MINUTES
SNOHOMISH DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH
February 13, 1964

Present: Members, Messrs. Wyatt, McCollum, Gebert, and Stocker. Also, Dr. Anderson, Dr. Darrough, Dr. Millard, Miss Jones, Miss Findlay, Mr. Stockton, Mr. Moser, Mr. Smith, Attorney, and Mrs. Supper.

Minutes Moved by Mr. Gebert, seconded by Mr. Wyatt, and carried that the minutes of January 7 and 20, 1964, and as previously circulated to members, be approved.

Auditing Committee Mr. McCollum appointed Mr. Gebert and Mr. Wyatt as the Auditing Committee.

Unfinished Business Dr. Anderson stated that he would report at a later date on the custody of mental patients before they appear in court.

Immunization Survey Dr. Anderson stated that the Snohomish County Medical Society had accepted the survey but wanted to regulate and control any publicity. The reason for this was that they did not want any type of fright or scare news. However, Dr. Anderson stated that he had been assured by the State Health Department that this survey would be conducted by a professional group. On further information he found that a professional group would not be involved, but that local personnel would be used. Dr. Anderson felt that the Board of Health had been misled in the first place in regards to the type of survey, not doubting the validity, but the Medical Society had been assured that this would be conducted by people outside the County. On this basis, we should not participate in a survey.

Reports Health Officer: Dr. Anderson stated that Snohomish County does not have an epidemic of flu. Only two counties, Whatcom and Skagit, have reached epidemic numbers of cases. If there is to be an epidemic in Snohomish County, it will probably appear within the next two weeks.
