MINUTES
SNOHOMISH DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH
November 10, 1964

Present: Members, Mrs. Simson, Messrs. Alexander, McCollum, Wyatt, and Stocker, Also, Dr. Anderson, Dr. Darrough, Dr. Millard, Miss Findlay, Mrs. Schultz, Mrs. Carleton, Mr. Stockton, Mr. Moser, Mr. Ingram, and Mrs. Supper.

Minutes Moved by Mrs. Simpson, seconded by Mr. Alexander, and carried that the minutes of October 13, 1964, and as previously circulated to members, be approved.

Auditing Committee Mr. McCollum appointed Mr. Simpson and Mr. Wyatt as the Auditing Committee.

School Employee Certification Fees Dr. Anderson enumerated the reasons as discussed in the October Board of Health meeting for raising the School Employee Certification Fee to \$2.00 per teacher for certification for two years (or \$1.00 per year). Moved by Mr. Alexander, seconded by Mr. Wyatt, and carried that the fee for all school employees' health certification shall be \$2.00 for a two year period, effective as of January 1, 1965.

County Meat Handling Ordinance Dr. Millard urged the passage of a County meat handler's ordinance such as the one which the City of Everett operates under, for the following reasons. At the present time, meat markets, wrapping plants, and other establishments handling fresh meats, pay only the \$10.00 Establishment fee. As the number of markets grow with the population, the number of visits necessary for inspection has increased, thereby causing the program to cost far more than the fees collected. Also many operators whose standards do not conform with the City ordinance have moved into the County where there is no ordinance. The Health District has no jurisdiction to enforce their standards nor to prosecute violations. The several meat wrapping plants now operating in the county especially need strict supervision. Some meat dealers in the County are asking for this protection to their own businesses and to the general public purchasing uninspected meat. Dr. Millard stated that he is drawing up an ordinance for the County Commissioners to examine. The State of Washington will probably eventually pass such an ordinance but he feels that Snohomish County can not wait and that it should be the Health District that does the inspecting and sets the fees.

Reports Dr. Anderson reported on his trip to New York where he attended the American Public Health Association Convention and also on his trip to Carville, Louisiana to visit the lepersarium located there.

Sanitation: Mr. Stockton reported that there is a sludge pit on one end of the Emander dump which is a safety problem as well as an odorous one. The County is trying to purchase land so that a dike can be built around it and then refuse will be dumped into it until it is filled.


