MINUTES  
SNOHOMISH DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH  
July 18, 1966

Due to the absence of a quorum on July 12, 1966, the meeting was postponed until July 18, 1966 at 1:30, and all members were duly notified.

Present Members, Mrs. Simpson, Messrs. Kraetz, Wyatt, Stocker, Alexander, and Krekow. Also, Dr. Darrough, Mr. Stockton, and Mrs. Supper.

Minutes Moved by Mr. Krekow, seconded by Mrs. Simpson, and carried that the minutes of June 14, 1966, as previously circulated to members, be approved as written.

Auditing Committee Mr. Kraetz appointed Mr. Alexander and Mr. Wyatt as the Auditing Committee.

Vehicle Sold Dr. Darrough stated that in accordance with motion of the Board on June 14, 1966, the 1959 Plymouth was sold for \$40.00 to S & M Auto Supply. Four sealed bids were obtained.

Budgetary Resolution Moved by Mr. Krekow, seconded by Mrs. Simpson, and carried that the attached resolution concerning the allocation and expenditure of dental health monies be adopted.

Sanitation Report Mr. Stockton reported that the problem of dumping sludge must be solved soon as the Health District and Mr. Wyatt are being besieged with complaints regarding the dumping of sludge from the entire county at the Lake Stevens site. Mr. Krekow stated that Mr. Rodney Colvin, City Engineer, was on vacation this week, but possibly upon his return would be able to set up a dumping station into the sewers. However, this still would not solve the problem of industrial wastes which cannot be put through the sewers and lagoon.

Total spent up to June 30, 1966: \$153,184.62


Authorization of Accounts Moved by Mr. Alexander, seconded by Mr. Wyatt, and carried that accounts as presented for payment be approved as follows:

- Meeting with Mayors Mr. Kraetz reported that on July 14, 1966, a very representative group of the mayors of Snohomish County met with him, Dr. Anderson, and other members of the Snohomish Health District staff to discuss the financial participation of the cities and towns in the Health District. The preliminary Budget for 1967, a list of services rendered by the Health District, and a sheet showing the requested financial participation of each city and town, have been mailed to each mayor, and another meeting has been scheduled for July 28, 1966.
- Public Health Veterinarian Mr. Alexander stated that he felt the Health District would lose an irreplaceable employee when Dr. Millard retires December 31, 1966. He asked the Board to consider raising Dr. Millard's salary to \$800 per month, as he felt Dr. Millard would stay one more year under this circumstance. Mr. Stockton stated that Dr. Millard had indicated he would remain one more year at a salary of \$750, which has been submitted in the preliminary budget for 1967.

RESOLUTION


