

MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING
SNOHOMISH DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH
May 23, 1967

Present Members, Mrs. Simpson, Messrs. Fowler, Harrison, Alexander, Fosse, Kincaid, Kraetz, and Krekow. Also, Dr. Anderson, Dr. Darrough, Mr. Moser, Mr. Magnum, Mrs. DeSoto, Mr. Ingram, Mr. Stockton, Mr. Thompson, Mr. Atkinson, and Mrs. Sherlock.

FHA Certification Request Mr. Moser reported that a letter had been received from the Alderwood Water District stating that it is not economically feasible for Mr. Anthony C. DiPangrazio to establish sewage disposal facilities at this time. Mr. Moser wrote to the FHA informing them of this and sent a copy of the letter to Mr. DiPangrazio. Mr. Moser further stated that he had received letters from the Alderwood Water District concerning two other plats whose owners were requesting such letters be sent to the FHA.

Future Requests for Certification to FHA Moved by Mr. Krekow, seconded by Mrs. Simpson, and carried that representatives from the County Planning Department, County Engineer's Department, FHA, and Alderwood Water District be invited to the next Board of Health meeting on June 13, 1967.

Mr. Moser reported that he had received a letter from the Alderwood Water District stating that in the future they would write feasibility letters to the FHA concerning subdivisions in that district.

Moved by Mr. Kincaid, seconded by Mrs. Simpson, and carried that the Alderwood Water District be advised that the Board of Health recognizes it as an authoritative body to certify the economic feasibility of adequate community water and/or sewage disposal facilities. All other established sewer districts shall be likewise advised.

Moved by Mrs. Simpson, seconded by Mr. Fosse, and carried that

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners are presently engaged in a comprehensive study of sewer problems in the County of Snohomish, and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Planning Commission through its sub-committee in acting upon proposed plats is concerned with the economic feasibility of community water and public sewer facilities,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Snohomish District Board of Health request the County Commissioners to act as the certifying agency under the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1965.

The County Commissioners present indicated that they would comply with the above request.
